

#### **PASTOR'S CORNER**

Dear Parish Family,

May Our Lord Jesus Christ grant you and your families many graces! During the month of November, we think about the whole community of saints—the Church triumphant in heaven, the Church suffering in purgatory, and the pilgrim Church (or Church militant) on earth. We are all members of God's Family. On November 1, we celebrate All Saints' Day; we remember those in heaven who, by Christ's grace, triumphed over sin and entered into eternal life. They see God face to face, and their souls await joyfully to be reunited with their bodies on the Last Day. They are already awarded eternally; and to use the words of St. Bernard, our honor of them is more for us than for them. We remember all the saints, not only the canonized ones, but also the unknown ones. We should make friends with the saints in heaven, because their prayers for us are powerful. On Saturday, November 1, we are having two Masses offered for All Saints Day. They are at 8am, one at St. Helen and one at Our **Lady of the Caves.** They are both Holy Day Masses, but they are not Holy Days of Obligation this year since they fall on Saturday.

On November 2, we celebrate All Souls' Day. On that day, each priest offers three Masses for the poor souls in purgatory. This is the Church Suffering. These holy souls have died in the state of grace, but they have not done enough penance to make atonement for their sins in this life, or they still have venial sins and too strong attachments for this earth. No one enters heaven with any stain of sin. Purgatory is a place of mercy where our remaining sins and effects of sin are purged away. The greatest pain for these holy souls is that the veil that kept them from seeing God is removed, but they cannot be with Him. Their greatest joy is that they know they will be with Him forever after their suffering. We should never forget our deceased loved ones. We are not the ultimate judge about where they are, so although we have hope that they are in heaven, we should be praying for them or having Masses for them in case they are in purgatory. So many souls in purgatory do not have anyone to pray for them because their loved ones just assume they are in heaven. Let us not forget the holy souls in purgatory; they are our brothers and sisters in the Family of God. Sunday, November 2ND, the Masses are at the usual times as all Sundays. There is also a rosary procession at the Glasgow Municipal Cemetery at 3pm. At 4pm, we will have an All Souls Devotion at the SH P.C., and pray for the souls of our deceased loved ones, especially for those we remember whose pictures are present there.

And finally, let us pray for one another here on earth. As it says in Sacred Scripture, the prayers of a holy person are powerful indeed. Let us strive for holiness and pray for one another, for we are all members of God's Family, the Communion of Saints! May God bless you and your loved ones!
