In the year 313 the Roman emperor Constantine published the Edict of Milan, granting religious freedom to Christians. Constantine himself donated the palace of the Lateran, a portion of his wife's dowry, to the Church for its first basilica. The Lateran is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome, the pope, and, as such, it ranks as the "mother and head of all the churches in the city and the world." From its dedication on this date in 324 until the 15th century, the Lateran was the residence of the popes. Within the interior, towering statues of the twelve apostles bearing the instruments of their martyrdom surround the central nave along the north and south walls.--Magnificat

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parish Family,

We read from the second book of Maccabees, "When he was near death, he said, 'It is my choice to die at the hands of men with the hope God gives of being raised up by Him.." (2 Mc 7:14). These words are spoken by the fourth of seven sons who are being tortured to death because they refuse to give up their faith in God. In fact, a mother is forced to watch her seven sons die because they refuse to give up their faith in God. Rather than pleading for her sons to save their own lives by denying their faith, she encourages them to remain faithful till death; at last she herself is executed for her faith.

This is great heroism. A mother and her sons choose death over compromising their faith in God. This is the kind of faith Jesus wants us to have in Him: "If you love your life more than Me, you are not worthy of Me." This wakes me up a bit. How much do I love Christ—really? Would I be willing to lose my family and friends, my comfort, my very life for His sake? Do I love Him over all? I know that I love Him, but would I give my life for him? I so hope that I would! I do know that I would surely apostatize to save my skin if I rely on my own strength. Without Christ, we can do nothing. We can only persevere if we remain united to Christ Who strengthens us. St. Paul says, "I can do all things in Christ Who strengthens me."

So what do I do, since I know how weak I am, since I know that of my own I would deny Christ like Simon Peter did? I must always cling to Christ, asking Him to give me the grace to do what I cannot do on my own, should Christ call me to martyrdom. But let us not be afraid. Our Lord does not want us to be fearful. With Him all things are possible. We can love Christ above all things with the help of His grace! How do we receive this kind of grace? By cooperating with Him, by seeking His will over all, by praying every day, by repenting of our sins every day, by getting back up to fight in the spiritual battle after every fall, by trying to love others as Christ loves them. Our Lord Jesus loves us more than we love ourselves. He treasures us, and He always wants us to come to Him! Do not be afraid! "Come to Me all you who are burdened, and I will give you rest!" May Our Lord Jesus Christ fill each of you with His grace! God bless you!
