PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parish Family,

"The desert and parched land will exult; the steppe will rejoice and bloom" (Isaiah 35:1). The third Sunday of Advent is called Gaudete Sunday, which means "Rejoice." The rose vestments that the priests and deacons wear symbolize joy. The third Advent candle, the rose one, is lit on this day. Why do we rejoice? Because the Lord Jesus is near. The prophet Isaiah describes the state of Israel, indeed the whole world, before the coming of Christ. Israel is like a parched desert waiting for the rain to refresh the ground. 
