#### PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parish Family,

Christmas is getting much closer, and we ponder more deeply of the supreme Gift of our Divine Giver—the supreme Gift is Christ, true God and true Man. On the quiet Christmas night, the world is changed. The Second Person of the Blessed Trinity, truly God, becomes visible to us. How does the world respond? Most of the world had no idea. Even many of God's own knew Him not. Many did not receive Him. Who did receive Him? Those who were humble and filled with self sacrifice.

Let us start with Mary and Joseph. Mary carries God in her womb, but she does not place herself above everyone else. 
