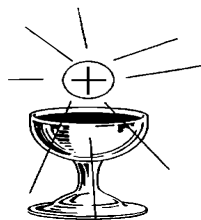

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parish Family,

In the Gospel today, Jesus describes the different places that the seed, the Word of God, is thrown. Some seeds fall on rocky ground, some seeds fall on the path, some seeds are thrown among briars and thorns, and some are thrown on good soil. Of course, these places represent our hearts. Some hearts are closed to receive the Word of God completely; some initially accept it, but then give it up when trouble comes; some accept it in the beginning but are distracted by the world and its pleasures and then give it up; and some embrace it and live it fully all the way to the end. Which are we? How are our hearts? Perhaps our hearts are different one day to the next. Sometimes we are committed, and sometimes we compromise our faith in the Gospel. In order to remain good soil, we need to be in touch with Jesus every day. We need to have a strong prayer life and each present moment to do God's will over our own. May we open our hearts to Christ every day!

In August, we have a few events coming up. First, Fr. Thomas, Fr. Michael and I are going to be on retreat at the Fathers of Mercy beginning Sunday night, August 2, and ending Friday evening, August 7.
